# Join us in the challenge! The Red-Letter Challenge that is.

Perhaps you have heard of some of the challenges that have become part of the Social Media landscape. In 2014, there was the Ice bucket challenge, and in 2018 the Tide pod challenge. After those came the gallon smash challenge and the fire challenge. My purpose in writing this is not to encourage you to participate in such social media challenges. In fact, I would urge you not to attempt any of them. I am, however, writing to encourage you to participate in the **Red-Letter Challenge** at Bethany. The Red-Letter Challenge is a book written by one of our LCMS Pastors, Zach Zehnder that focuses on some of the words of Jesus in the four Gospels.

If you participate in the Red-Letter Challenge at Bethany, you will spend six-weeks reading and studying the Words of Jesus. In addition, you will be challenged each week to put into practice Jesus' words in your daily life. Each week you will also meet with other members of Bethany for a small group discussion (6-8 people). You'll have a small group leader with a discussion guide to help in the weekly conversation.

Week 2: Week of Being (with Jesus)

Week 3: Week of Forgiving

Week 4: Week of Serving

Week 5: Week of Giving

## Passover (Seder) Celebration

## Wednesday, March 27th at 6:00 - 8:30 pm in Fellowship Hall

Please join us for Passover. We will see how Jesus celebrated Passover with His disciples. We will see how Jesus used unleavened bread and wine of the Passover to become His body and blood in Holy Communion. As we celebrate the Passover, we will sample foods eaten during a traditional Jewish Passover. A modern Passover involves a meal. For our Passover, we will have a potluck.

Those attending are asked to bring a part of the food or other items used in the Passover (easy items). This can be done when signing up.
